### **IEVFS Monthly Meeting Minutes**

IEVFS Minutes, September 24, 2023 Meeting was held in person and via ZOOM. Meeting was called to order at approximately 4:49 p.m.

Members in Attendance in person: Jackie Aronowitz, Dana Armstrong, Diana Irving, Aida Rodriguez, Rod Terrell, and Heidi Knight

Members attending via ZOOM: Justin Chalk, Byron West

Topic/Speaker: There was no topic.

<u>Minutes:</u> August minutes were reviewed. Revised to show Heidi Knight attended meeting and to add clarinet as one of the instruments used by the Festivo Ensemble. Jackie moved and Diana seconded that the August 2023 minutes, as corrected, be approved. All present voted in favor. Minutes were approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Dana reported that there is \$1,162.76 in the IEVFS checking account. Pending deposits include a check for \$279.53 from the Pampered Chef fundraiser and \$30 for membership dues from new member Kay Saisim. Pending expense of \$50 for Smart Access services for September. Expenses have increased due to the scholarship cost of \$100 per month. There are 17 members. Renewals have been sent out.
