

Inland Empire Valley Flute Society Annual Flute Lesson Scholarship

Purpose:

This scholarship is designed to help a dedicated flute student who is experiencing financial difficulties which are affecting their lessons.

The scholarship will cover half (50%) of the cost of a student's flute lesson fees for six (6) months. In addition, the winner of this scholarship will receive one (1) year IEVFS membership, subject to available funding.

Note: Scholarship maxes out at \$50 per lesson and \$600 for the six month period.

Requirements:

- If awarded scholarship, applicant must become a member of the Inland Empire Valley Flute Society <u>OR</u> the applicant must be a current student of a Teacher Member of IEVFS (Membership dues must be current).
- Individuals of all ages and abilities are eligible.
- Applicants must submit:
 - Completed Scholarship Application
 - o Statement of Interest in Scholarship
 - o Musical Resume
 - Instructor Recommendation
 - Parent/Guardian Statement (minors only)
- Incomplete applications will be disqualified

- Awarding of scholarship based on financial need and student dedication as demonstrated in their application materials.
- Please write legibly. Applications that cannot be read will be disqualified.
- Previous IEVFS scholarship applicants and awardees are encouraged to apply again.
- If awarded, the scholarship will cover half (50%) of the cost of monthly flute lessons for six (6) months. The student is responsible for paying the other half (50%) of the lesson fees. The instructor agrees not to change the price of their lessons while the student is receiving the scholarship. Scholarship is for lessons only.
- The scholarship winner will perform for IEVFS at a meeting of the IEVFS. Failure to perform will result in a forfeit of the scholarship.
- The winner will forfeit the scholarship if they do not continue their lessons for the six (6) months that they are receiving the scholarship
- Should the winner choose to change teachers while receiving the scholarship, they must notify the IEVFS Board immediately. The winner may continue receiving the

scholarship. The amount of the scholarship paid by IEVFS will not be adjusted for higher lesson fees.

- Applicants will be notified of the results of their application by mail.
- All application materials become the property of IEVFS upon receipt.
- All decisions of the IEVFS Scholarship Committee are final.
