IEVFS Minutes, October 23, 2022 Meeting was held in person and via ZOOM.

Meeting was called to order at approximately 4:38 p.m. Members in Attendance in person: Jackie Aronowitz, Dana Armstrong Members attending via ZOOM: Justin Chalk, Rod Terrell Guest(s): Aida Rodriguez

Topic/Presentation: There was no topic/presentation this month. There was an announcement that our beloved long-time IEVFS member, friend, and Parliamentarian Harriet Foucher had passed away in early October. Harriet had been a part of the IEVFS since its inception. She was a loyal and dedicated member who kept us in line with rules and procedures and contributed greatly to the IEVFS. She was a wonderful person and will be greatly missed by all who were fortunate to know her.

Minutes: The August 2022 minutes are still pending. There was no quorum (five members needed), so minutes could not be adopted.

Treasurer's Report: Dana reported on finances but did not prepare a Treasurer's report. As of Oct. 23, there was \$1,580.76 in the checking account. Smart Access was paid for Oct. ZELLE: IEVFS can now accept payments through ZELLE as of late 2021.

Website: Updates needed. Placeholder has been added in "Events" tab for Young Artists Competition.

Young Flutists Competition: Since the September meeting, there were several unfortunate developments, leading to a decision to postpone the event. Specifically, the evaluator we had signed up notified us that she could not participate, due to a scheduling conflict. In addition, the venue (Our Spirit of the Savior Church in San Bernardino) had a flooding issue in their fellowship hall, where the event was going to be held. Flooring was being removed and needed to be replaced.

We will aim to hold the competition in the spring. Jackie suggests changing venue to Victoria Seventh Day Adventist Church in San Bernardino. IEVFS has a long partnership with that church which has provided space at no charge. Jackie will check with them.
